The "Nashcar" Outhouse Race

(on your mark, get set,.....GO!!)

The "Nashcar" Outhouse Race is a highlight of the "Abe Martin's County Picnic" every year. These are very creative and inventive racing creations entered by various participants. The requirements are simple and participation is open to personal teams as well as business sponsored teams.

There are two entry types:

- Division 1 (Stock, which is built on a WCG provided base), and;
- Division 2 (Modified, which is totally custom built by the entering persons or organization)

Physical demands for the race are limited to participation in the Corn Hole and Plunger Toss games for which each team is awarded points based on their performance. The race itself is gravity driven, with Outhouses being released at the top of the hill in front of The Hobnob Restaurant. Winner is actually determined by the longest run before coming to a stop. Trophy's are awarded for;

- Community Choice - most money raised through \$1 votes in the community voting;
- Corn Hole Winner;
- Plunger Toss Winner;
- Best Team Performance/Appearance Winner;
- Division 1 Stock Race Winner;
- Division 2 Modified Race Winner;
- Grand Champion - Determined by total number of points earned for all events.

Outhouses can be as simple or as fancy as you desire, sizes are limited though. All must be gravity driven only, must have steering to maneuver, must be built in good taste, must resemble an Outhouse, and above all, must be soundly built, sturdy, stabile, (not top heavy so as to be prone to tip over), and have 4 wheels and tires that are in safe useable condition.

Rules

Note: First rule of consideration is SAFETY for the racer & public. A safety committee will review all outhouses prior to the race activities.

Two Race Divisions

Division 1) OUTHOUSE WITH OUR BASE, USING OUR WHEELS

Division 2) ALL OTHER BASES (must submit a drawing for approval)

Outhouse Racers: - Must have a theme

- 1) Entries must look like an outhouse and be in good taste
- 2) Entries must have no sharp edges on the Outhouse Racer
- 3) Size and design requirements:

Division 1): 36"x36", built on WCG supplied base, Height- minimum 72" to a maximum of 96" from the ground to the highest point on the Outhouse.
(*Loaner bases limited to availability and must be returned to We Care Gang*)

Division 2): Outhouses must measure between 36"-60" long and 36"-48" wide plus wheel width, when in racing position. Overall wheel width is not to exceed 60". Height must not exceed 96" from the ground to the highest point on the Outhouse. Division 2 entries must resemble an Outhouse when parked or in a static position.

- 4) All entries must have 4 wheels that are in good safe operating condition and be free rolling.
- 5) Must be built of solid material and be structurally sound.
- 6) Must have 4 sides with good forward visibility for the driver
- 7) Must not be "Top Heavy". Outhouse must remain stable when sitting on a 30 degree slope with the driver seated. (Must not tip in any direction)
- 8) Driver must be seated in the Outhouse and maintain steering control during the race activities.
- 9) Entries must be in good taste- We Care Gang reserves the right to determine.
- 10) No handles may protrude from either side of the entry for spectator safety.
- 11) Teams must maintain safe control of their Outhouse at all times.
- 12) Driver must be at least 16 years old.
- 13) All entrants must sign a waiver to hold harmless agreement at registration before they can participate in any event. Under 18 must have parent or guardian signature.
- 14) This is a non-sanctioned, community event, intended for fun only, and teams are expected to act in a good "Sportsman like" manner at all times.
- 15) Teams are responsible for the removal and transportation of their entries following the completion of the event. Racers are not to be left on site without prior arrangements for transportation to storage.

Team:

- Pit crew of 2, plus 1 driver (Pit Crew will compete in the Cornhole Tournament and the Plunger Toss)
- Pit crew and driver should be dressed in apparel accordingly to the theme
- All members must be 14 or older
- All members must sign a waiver to hold harmless agreement, before they can participate

Logistics:

Entries are encouraged to be dropped off for display on Friday afternoon if possible. Entries must be in assigned pits (on West Main Street) on Saturday, Sept 18th, by 10:00 AM, for Judging.

Scoring:

Points: 1st = 20 pts, 2nd = 15 pts, 3rd = 10 pts

- 1) Team points for Cornhole
- 2) Team points for Plunger Toss
- 3) Best dressed Team
- 4) Division 1 Outhouse Races
- 5) Division 2 Outhouse Races
- 6) Community Choice- Who raises the most money through the collection of \$1 votes. (*See Note below)
- 7) Grand Champion – Team with the highest total combined points

*Note: Abe Martin's County Picnic and NashCar Outhouse Races are intended to be enjoyable for all. The event is We Care Gang's largest fundraiser for the year and proceeds are used to provide assistance with Food, Shelter, Health, and Basic Living Needs for needy persons in Brown County. Community Choice votes may be collected at anytime prior to and throughout the event.
