ABE MARTIN'S COUNTY PICNIC SEPTEMBER 13, 2008

The 4th Annual Abe Martin's County Picnic will be held on Saturday, September 13, 2008. The annual picnic is the largest event organized by Brown County's We Care Gang and takes place in the streets of Nashville centered at the intersection of Jefferson and Main Streets. The Picnic has dual purposes; first to raise money to be used for Food, Shelter, Health, and Basic Living Needs for the poor in Brown County; and secondly to build community spirit by providing an event that includes fellowship, live music, games, and fun for all that attend. This event is open to all that wish to participate and everyone is welcome.

The 4th Annual "Nashcar Outhouse Races" will take place later in the afternoon and the Indiana Pacers "Bowser" will be on hand to wave the checkered flag. Outhouse Race Team entries will compete for points through the Plunger Toss competition and Corn Hole competitions. Teams will also compete for "Community Choice" which is determined by the most \$1.00

votes collected and for best overall team and entry appearance/performance. The race begins at the top of the hill in front of the Hobnob Restaurant and runs down hill, west, towards the Gazebo. There are limited entry positions available, for entry information and rules, visit our website at:

WHAT IS THE WE CARE GANG?

The "We Care Gang" (WCG) was organized in 2005 by a small group of local citizens with a common desire to build community spirit while raising money to help those in need with food and shelter related needs. Our desire has always been to target those that may fall through the cracks of traditional assistance and especially those that suffer in silence because of their personal pride. The group relies on references of established organizations and trusted community leadership for help in identifying the legitimate needs of Brown County Citizens-we do not generally respond to individual direct requests. Assistance is not given directly to any individual, but instead, it is paid to the supplier of the service or material that is needed. For example, WCG has provided assistance by paying a propane supplier or electric company in an emergency situation. WCG has provided health related supplies to the BC Health Department during recent flood disasters and paid for lodging for 1-3 nights for victims who were left homeless after the disaster. WCG has also provided assistance through donations to local food banks. Since our inception, WCG has provided over \$15,000.00 in assistance here in Brown County.

The "We Care Gang" is a non-political, non-denominational group of your neighbors, friends, and acquaintances who want to contribute to the community we live in. There is no "I" in We Care Gang, it is all about "We", and "We" includes all of those that help throughout the year, those that volunteer to help during our various events, the generous donors and sponsors of our activities, and everyone that supports the events with their attendance and participation. 2008 NASHCAR OUTHOUSE ENTRY POSITIONS STILL AVAILABLE

There are a limited number of entry positions, for this years "NashCar" Outhouse Races, still available. The requirements are simple and participation is open to personal teams as well as business sponsored teams. There are two entry types, Stock, which is built on a WCG provided base, and Modified, which is totally custom built by the entering persons or organization. Physical demands for the race are limited to participation in the Corn Hole and Plunger Toss games at which each team is awarded points

based on their performance. The race itself is gravity driven, with Outhouses being released at the top of the hill in front of The Hobnob Restaurant. Winner is actually determined by the longest run before coming to a stop. Trophy's are awarded for: Most money raised through \$1 votes in the community choice voting, Corn Hole Winner, Plunger Toss Winner, Best Team Performance/ Appearance Winner, and Stock Race Winner, Modified Race Winner, and Grand Champion which is determined by total number of points earned for all

events. Outhouses can be as simple or as fancy as you desire, sizes are limited though. All must be gravity driven only, must have steering to maneuver, must be built in good taste, must resemble an Outhouse, and above all, must be soundly built, sturdy, stabile, (not top heavy so as to be prone to tip over), have 4 wheels and tires that are in safe condition.
